His family and his buddies and even his girl friend had mourned him as dead and then more or less got over their grief. His sudden reappearance was disturbing to say the least. They had all loved him, but they had in effect written him out of their lives. His girl friend was engaged to marry someone else. Moreover, he didn't seem like the boy who had gone off to war.

His family went to the priest. There's something wrong with him, they said. There sure is, the priest replied, he has risen from the dead and now lives a new life.
